

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MATERIALS SUBMITTED TO THE SCIENTIFIC JOURNAL SCIENTIFIC HORIZONS.

"Scientific Horizons" is a monthly scientific professional edition that publishes articles in the field of agricultural, veterinary, technical and economic sciences.

The editorial board of the collection accepts for publication the scientific articles in Ukrainian, English and Russian if they meet the requirements of paragraph 3 of the Resolution of the Presidium of the Higher Attestation Commission of Ukraine dated 15.01.2003 № 7-05 / 1 "On Increasing the Requirements for Professional Editions Included in the List of the Higher Attestation Commission of Ukraine" and the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 32 dated January 15, 2018 "On Approval of the Procedure for the Formation of the List of Scientific Professional Publications of Ukraine".

Structure of the article:

1. UDC Index (left alignment).
2. The title of the article should correspond to its contents (no more than 12 words), (center alignment, capital letters, bold font).
3. Initials and surnames of authors (center alignment).
4. E-mail address of authors (center alignment).
5. Full official name and legal address of the institution of the authors (center alignment).
6. Abstract in article language (at least 1800 characters, including keywords).
7. Keywords: 4-10 words (phrases), (italic, alignment in width).
8. The text of the article (alignment in width).

The presentation of the main material is carried out in the following order:

problem statement

analysis of recent researches and publications;

purpose, tasks and methods of research;

study results;

conclusions and perspectives of further research.

9. References (alignment in width).

The list of references is made in accordance with the existing standards of bibliographic description (DSTU 8302: 2015). The reference to the source should be indicated in the text in square brackets with the serial number. The references to the sources of recent years should prevail in the list of literature. Avoid references to your own scientific work (no more than one). It is inadvisable to use Internet publications (except for scientific ones, sources should be available), abstracts, reports, thesis and dissertations.

10. References (alignment in width).

A separate transliterated reference list should be provided in Latin (preferably in the APA style - American Psychological Association, (<http://www.apastyle.org/>) in accordance with the requirements of world abstract databases, with DOI indices, available at <https://www.crossref.org> Transliteration of the Ukrainian (Russian) alphabet in Latin is required in accordance with the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated January 27, 2010, No. 55. Foreign-language literature sources should be given in the language of the original. For automatic transliteration you can also use the site <http://translate.meta.ua/ua/translit/>. The examples of reference list are added.

11. Abstract in English and Russian (at least 1800 characters, including keywords), with the initials and authors' names, the title of the article, the full official name and legal address of the institution. If the article is in English, then the resume is submitted in Ukrainian and Russian, respectively. An English version of the article is accepted only if it is translated professionally. If you submit an English version translated using Internet Translators (e.g. Google), the materials will be rejected.

The manuscript of a scientific paper should be submitted along with its electronic version in the format doc., executed in the editor of Microsoft Word (any version). The volume of the article is up to 12 pages of the text A4 format (210x297 mm), including tables, illustrative material and bibliographic list.

Page setup: portrait orientation; fields - 20 mm from all sides. Parameters of the paragraph: first line (paragraph) indent - 1.0 cm, font - Times New Roman, font size - 14 pt, interval - 1.0, alignment - the width of the page.

Tables, drawings, graphs, formulas are given after making reference to them in the text and must be numbered in Arabic letters (portrait orientation). All abbreviations should be expanded. In the tables, the words

must be written in full and hyphenation should be arranged correctly.

Formulas must be written in Equation Editor, mathematical variables in the text should be in italics.

The drawings and photos should be centered, without text wrap, the way of filling the "Pattern"- in black and white.

All dimensions of quantities must be submitted in accordance with the International System of Units (SI). Between the units of measure and the characters and numbers to which they belong, a space is placed.

Articles are sent to the editorial board only in electronic formats. The authors are responsible for the authenticity of the content and the plagiarism of the submitted materials. For the convenience of the authors we recommend that you use the articles published in the last issue of the collection as a model.

The article is accompanied by information about the authors, in separate file, which provides: the surname, name, and patronymic of the author; scientific degree, academic status; place of employment, position; correspondence address; phone, email address (required). The filename must match the author's last name. For example: Ivanchuk_ Article, Ivanchuk_ Information.

Scientific articles submitted to the editorial board are necessarily subjected to independent peer-review by leading specialists in the relevant field of science. If the article is returned for revision, the author must take into account all comments of the editorial board. Articles returned after revision later than in a month are considered as new acquisitions. The editorial board reserves the right to correct and edit the text. Manuscripts rejected by the editorial board do not come back to the authors. An article that is not recommended by the reviewer for publication is not accepted for re-examination.

The final decision on the publication of the article is taken by the collection editorial board.
